Mental Health First Aid teaches you how to identify, understand, and respond to signs of mental illness and substance abuse disorders. This training gives you the skills you need to reach out and provide initial support to someone who may be developing a mental health or substance use problem and help connect them to the appropriate care.

MENTAL HEALTH SCREENINGS

- Mental Health Screenings are available 24/7 online at MHAScreening.org.
- They're free and anonymous and you can email yourself the results.
- If you're not sure if what you're going through is serious or not, it's a good way to get some feedback.
- It is also helpful to check in with your primary care provider about your symptoms.
- The screenings are tools we adapted for the internet. You'll also find some extra resources available after each one or under "DIY Tools" at the bottom of the webpage.
- If you want to test them or check them out, just put "test" in the zip code area.
- Over 28,000 screenings last year tell us Kentuckians need more mental health information and education.





988 MENTAL HEALTH HOTLINE: CALL / TEXT / CHAT ONLINE

The Lifeline not only provides 24/7, free and confidential support for people in distress, but also prevention and crisis resources for you or your loved ones, and best practices for professionals in the United States.

When people call, text, or chat 988, they will be connected to trained counselors (usually Kentuckians) that are part of the existing Lifeline network. These trained counselors will listen, understand how their problems are affecting them, provide support, and connect them to resources if necessary.


